A sweeter white wine with hints of apricot and pineapple. Finishes with a trace of grapefruit. It is produced from the Frontenac Gris grape.

Arguably one of the most recognized pieces of art, Van Gogh's Starry Night has been interpreted several ways over the years. It has been associated with the loss of his ear, as well as biblical references. Nobody really knows the story behind the painting, but it is known that he completed this work from memory because he was institutionalized at the time. In a letter to his brother, Van Gogh recognized that the painting was surreal. Starry Night's often are.
