Light bodied and refreshing with balanced acidity. Green apple and persimmon flavors with a touch of honey make for a pleasant, balanced finish.

The name of this wine was taken from a poem written by A.L.Fink entitled The Rose Still Grows Beyond the Wall. Over the years, there have been many interpretation of this poem, including songs by Aretha Franklin and Tupac Shakur. Interpretations including humble beginnings leading to greatness and comforting words for those dealing with the loss of a loved one. I had always wanted to offer a Riesling to our customers. Customers frequently asked if we had it in our offerings and it is one of my favorite wines. During our first 8 years in business, other more pressing issues seemed to always come to the forefront and overtime producing a Riesling was lost in the day-to-day shuffle of operations. Upon the passing of Uncle Andy and Aunt Dottie in August of 2022, I had the opportunity to attend their memorial service where this poem was read. Although not physically present during those few days spent in New Hampshire, I felt the impact they had on my life. The rose still grew, inspiring the additional of this wine to our offerings.
